We believe the 2011 UPPERLIMB.COM Cunningham Classic is the toughest and most prestigious one day road race classic in Queensland and we thank you for your continued support.

RACE BRIEFING

OFFICIALS

Chief Commissaire: Greg Vincent

SAFETY

Riders must follow all Queensland road rules during the race. Failure to do so may result in a fine by race officials or police. Riders may also be disqualified or face Cycling Queensland sanctions.

In the interests of safety for both riders and motorists and to comply with the Department of Main Roads and Police Permits, we ask that rider support vehicles do not follow the race. It is therefore required that all vehicles leave the Gatton start before 9.10am. Drivers of vehicles following the race will be warned and/or fined by the police and their rider may be disqualified.

Vehicles are permitted to proceed to the top of the Main Range to the King of the Mountain line (approx 41km), the drinks and feeding stations or the finish line in Warwick. Competitors are encouraged to leave warm-up clothing etc with their race groups' official vehicle.

No vehicles are permitted to park on the finish straight in either direction. Victoria Street will be intermittently closed to traffic as each group finishes. This area will be controlled by the SES and race officials whose directions must be obeyed.

Failure to comply with the safety rules of the race may result in disqualification and official sanctions from Cycling Queensland.

Thank you, we appreciate your co-operation in assisting with the duty of care to maintain the safety of our riders and other road users.

DRINK AND FEED STATIONS

All competitors leaving Gatton (except Elite A Grade) can take on drinks at the designated drinks station. This is at Pilton Hall, approximately 48.5km from the start and 7.5km after the King of the Mountain.

Elite A Grade Men have two feed stations. The first is approximately 2km after the Clifton turnoff (62km from start). The second is 10km before Allora on Dalrymple Creek Road (approx 132km from start). As some of the roads are narrow and to avoid traffic congestion, it is requested that once riders have been fed at the first feed station that the riders support personnel return to the New England Highway and proceed to Allora. 2km from turning into Allora Rd, turn right into Dalrymple Creek Road and travel for 10km to the second feed station.

RACE BRIEFING

RACE NUMBERS

Each rider will receive two race numbers. One is to be pinned on the jersey pockets in the centre and the other to the side at the lower left rib cage.

We encourage competitors to keep their race numbers as a souvenir of the event.

JUNIOR U/19 ROLL OUT

Junior U/19 riders are required to meet their specified roll out requirement of 7.93 metres.

ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS

No electronic communication devices are allowed in individual events in Queensland including this race. This is not a teams event.

WOMEN'S RACING

Women will race with men, combined in an appropriate division and compete for the same overall places in that division. Women may also be eligible for "unplaced women's" prizes as indicated in the details for each division.

CLAIMING RACE PLACES

Riders are requested to claim their places at the finish line following each race.

Race places may include UPPERLIMB.COM 1st to 5th place overall, Avanti Plus The Valley King of the Mountain, Avanti Plus The Valley Queen of the Mountain and unplaced women. Detailed information is provided on each start list.

COLLECTING LICENCES

Licences will be held for the duration of the race and will be available for collection 15 minutes after the arrival of the commissaire for each grade at the Avanti Plus The Valley tent at the finish line in Warwick.

PRESENTATIONS AND PRIZE DRAW

The official presentation will be held as soon as possible after completion of the last race at the Horse & Jockey Hotel / Motel, two blocks from the finish on Victoria Street. Lunch, snacks and drinks are available at this venue.

We have a large range of fantastic prizes to win in our random prize draw for all competitors in attendance at the presentation ceremony.

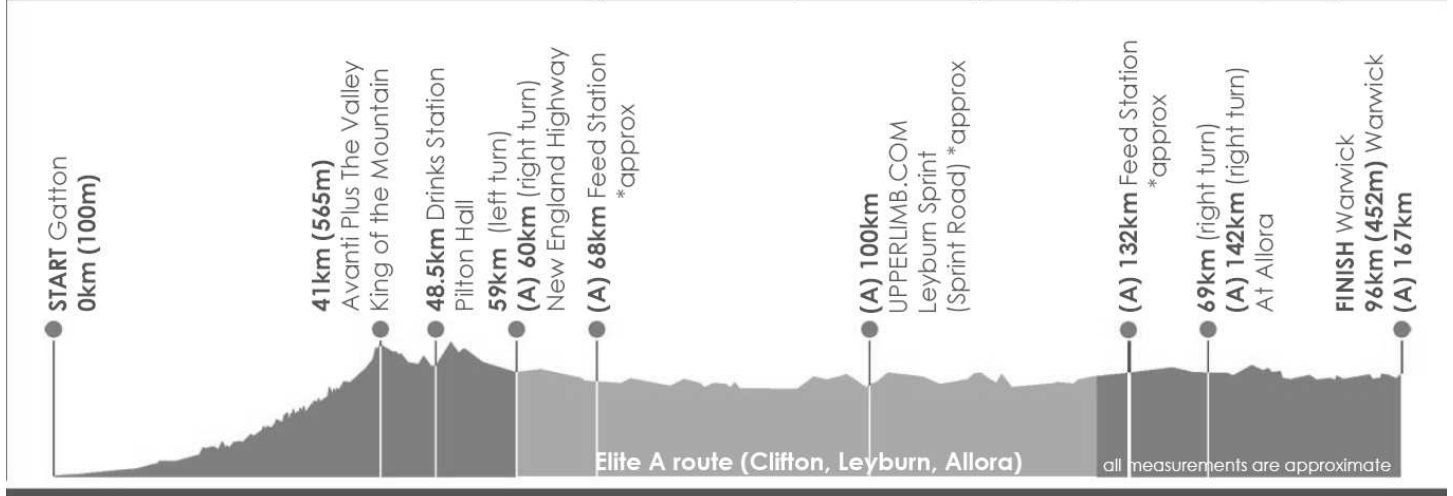

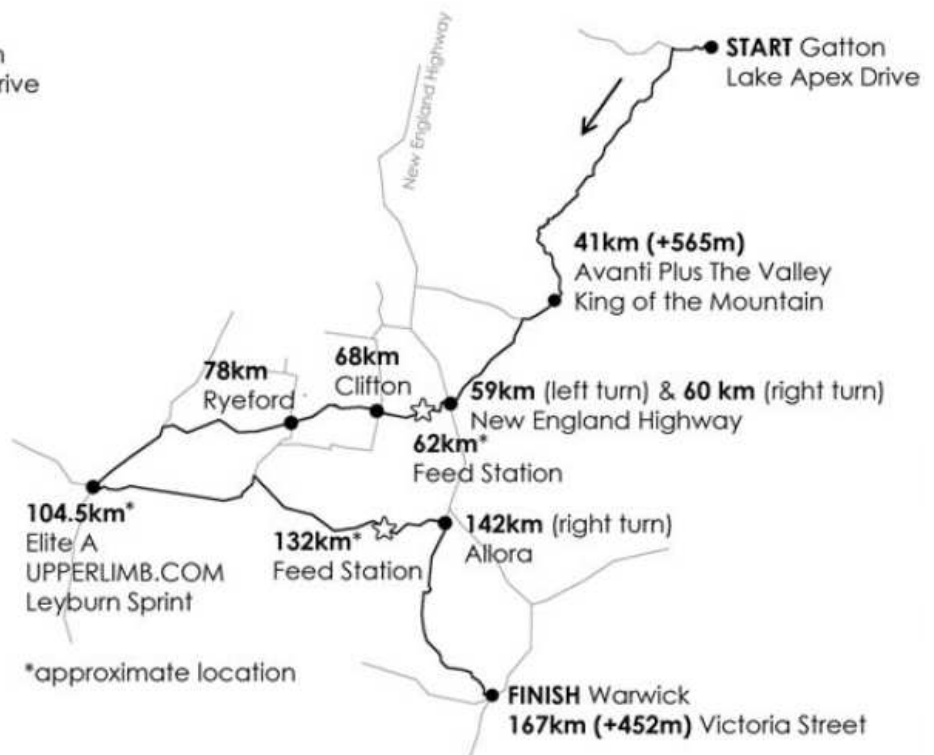
